May the spirit of the season be with you and your family. Merry Christmas and happy New Year!

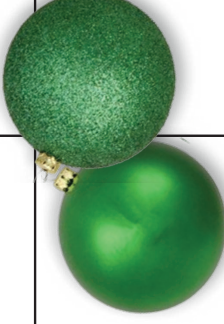

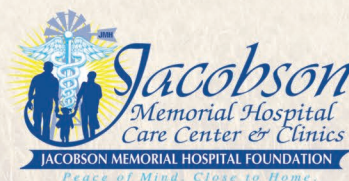


The Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation welcomes donations anytime.
