Gifts of Livestock

A COMMUNITY DONATION

As an active rancher, you have a unique opportunity to help your local health care facility with a “community donation of livestock.”

Ranchers can make “above-the-line” charitable contributions of livestock that can be readily marketable by the Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation. By contributing unsold livestock to the Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation, rather than selling the livestock and donating cash, you may be able to attain certain tax advantages.

When a producer transfers ownership of livestock to a foundation before it is sold, the producer will not have taxable income from the sale. Instead of selling the livestock, the producer transfers ownership of the livestock directly to the foundation. Producers may then claim their production costs as deductible expenses for income tax purposes.

Please consult a tax advisor to learn how this type of contribution fits your tax situation.

HOW TO DONATE

1) Contact Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation (JMHF) to inform us that the gift is to be made. Contact the Foundation Director at 701-584-2792 or foundation@jacobsonhospital.org.

2) Complete the “Letter from the Producer” regarding the Gifts of Livestock on the website at www.jacobsonhospital.org or request a form at the telephone number above. Indicate the type and quantity of livestock being contributed. Send the form to the Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation, P.O. Box 367, Elgin, ND 58533.

3) We request that you deliver the livestock to market on behalf of the JMHF and will provide you with a completed form, “Instructions to Sale Barn for Gifts of Livestock.”

4) Deliver the livestock to market on behalf of the JMHF and provide a copy of your “Letter from the Producer” and completed “Instructions to Sale Barn for Gifts of Livestock.”

5) Remind the sales barn to issue the check for the sale of the livestock to the Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation and send it to: P.O. Box 367, Elgin, ND 58533.

It is important to follow these steps to receive the intended tax benefits.
