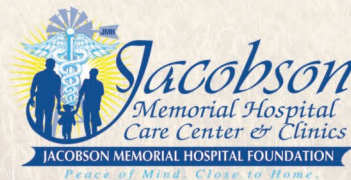


The Jacobson Memorial Hospital Foundation welcomes donations anytime.
